

As per the safer recruitment requirements detailed in Keeping Children Safe in Education, we will need to verify a candidate's identity as part of the recruitment process. Candidates will need to provide **two** forms of identification from the following list:

passport (including biometric passports)

identity card from an EU or European Economic Area (EEA) country, including those that provide biometric information

UK photocard driving licenses

a UK biometric residence permit

EU or EEA driving licenses

- a Northern Ireland electoral identity card
- a US passport card
- a bank, building society or credit union current account (this can be evidenced with a bank card or statement)
- a student loan account
- a credit account
- a mortgage account (including buy to let mortgage accounts)
- a digital tachograph driver smart card
- an armed forces identity card
- a proof of age card recognised under PASS
- a loan account (including hire purchase accounts)
- a 'high' electronic identity from a notified eIDAS scheme
